  - ❖ Word count must be between 250-800 words
  - ❖ Stories must be typed, on one side of an 8 ½ x 11 page
    - ❖ Illustrations are welcome on 8 ½ x 11 paper
      - Only one story submission per person
    - ❖ Titles should be on the FRONT of the first page
  - Please label the BACK of the last page with your name, grade, phone number, and word count
    - No staples please
    - Submit stories no later than 4pm on Saturday, November 30, 2013
