Join 5th grade teacher, Bryan Sheckells for science fun. Explore a different scientific endeavor each week with stories, multi-media, experiments, games and more!

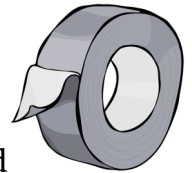


Junior Edition: for children ages 6 to 8

July 5: Rockets - Blast your way to summer fun with water powered rockets! Design your own nose cone or fins to achieve maximum height.

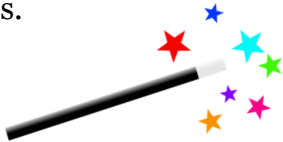
