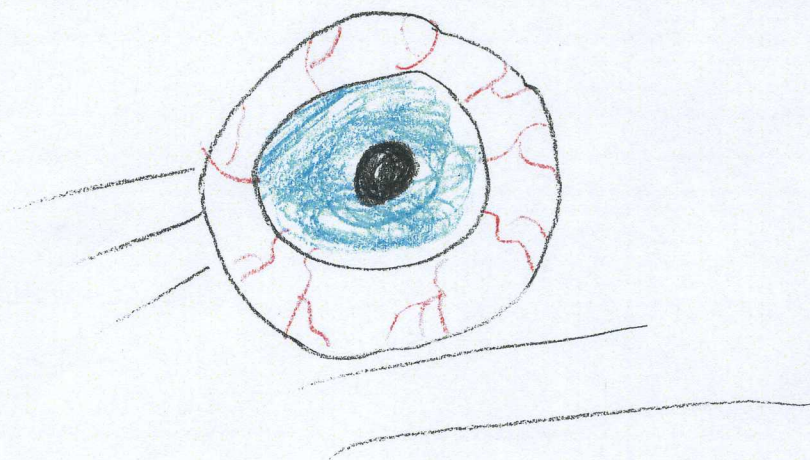


THE

EYEBALL



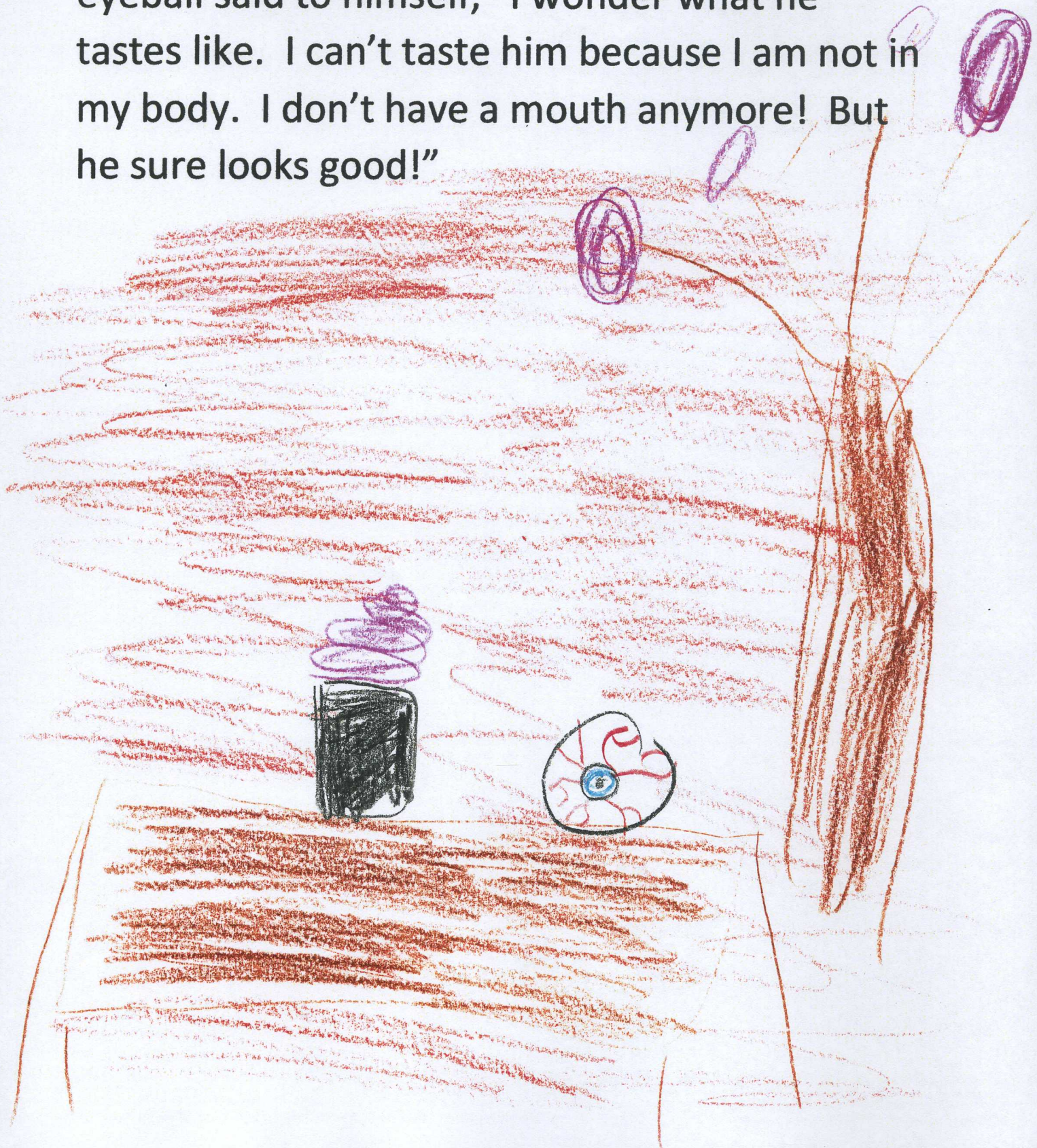
Once upon a time, there was an eyeball.

hopped around.



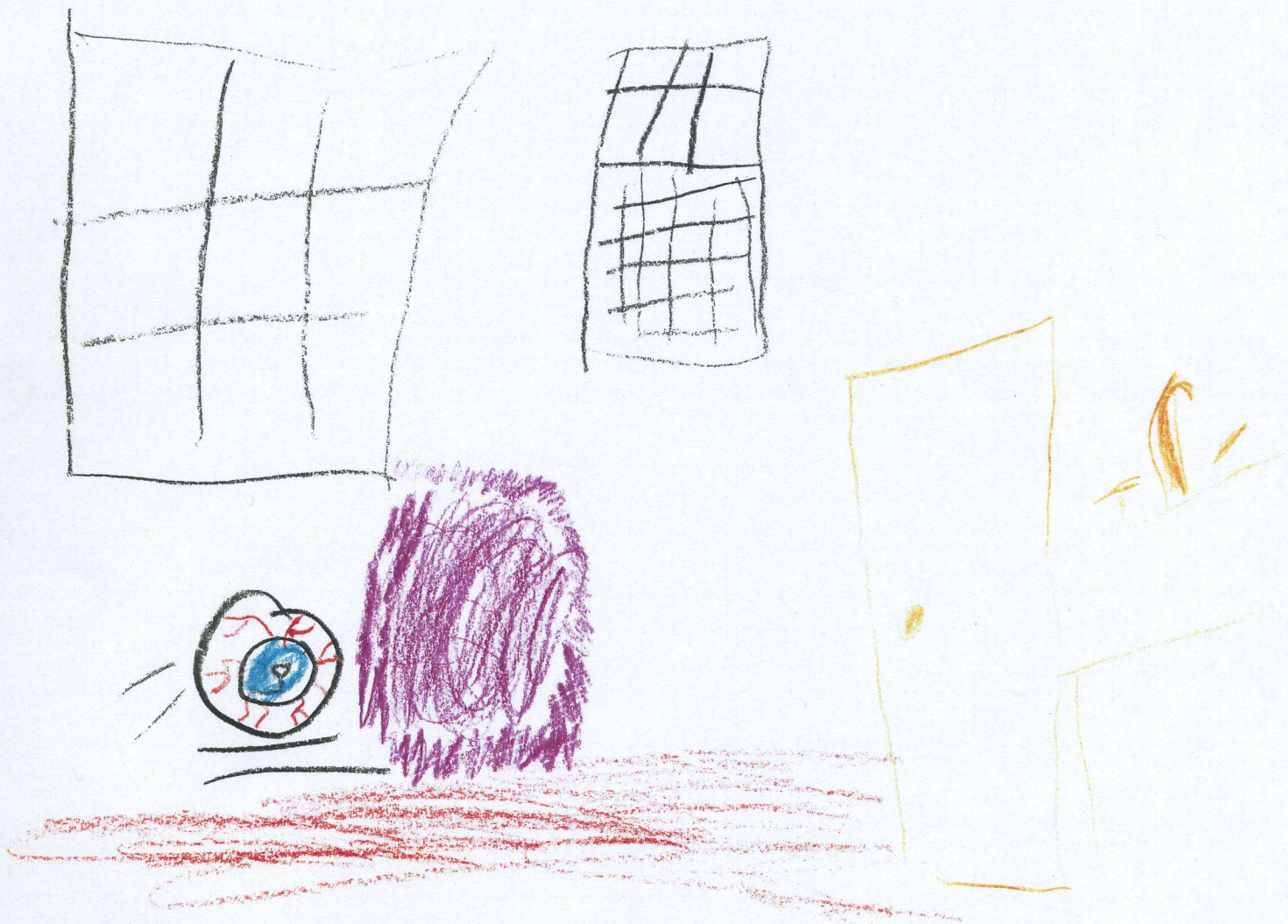

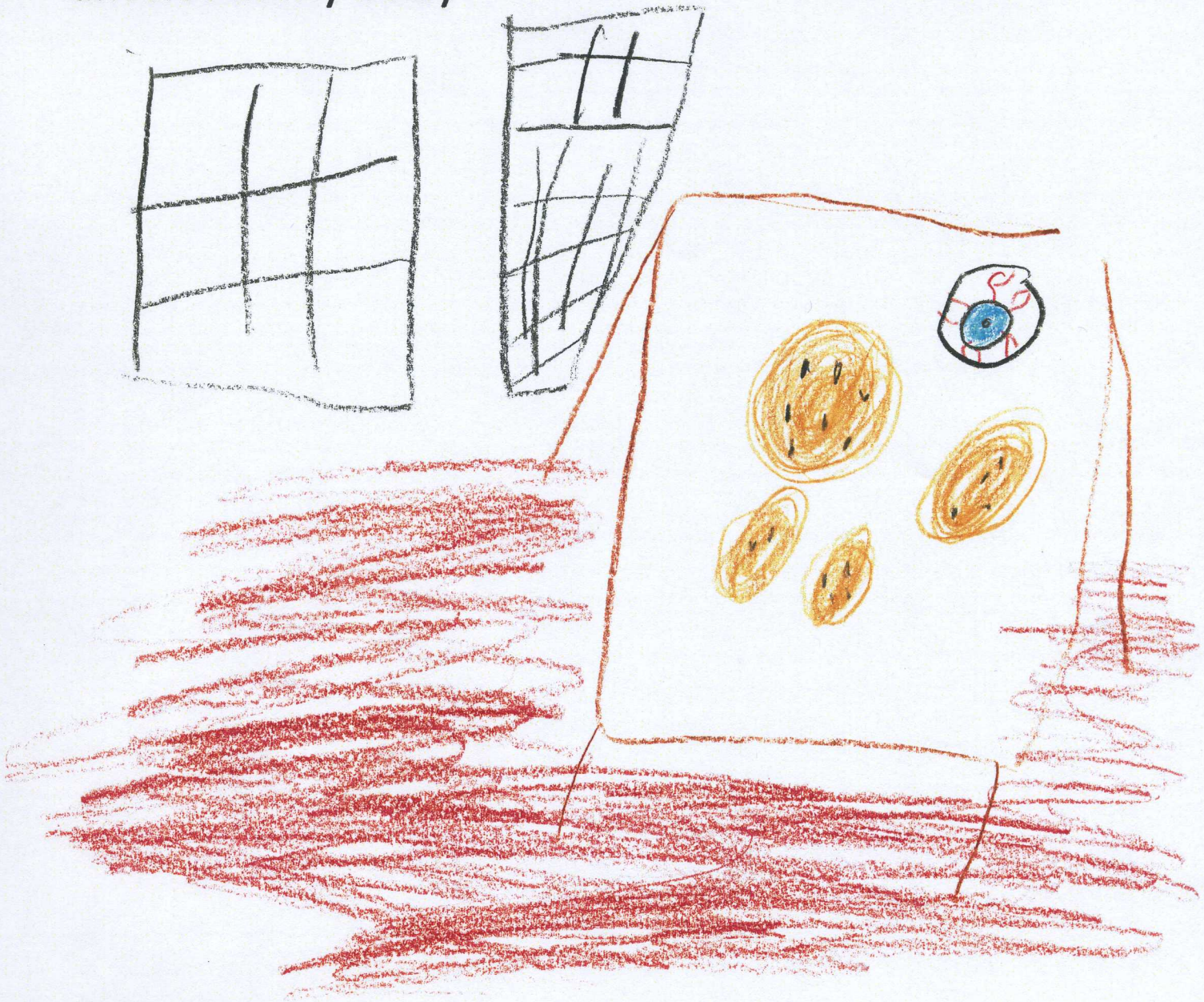

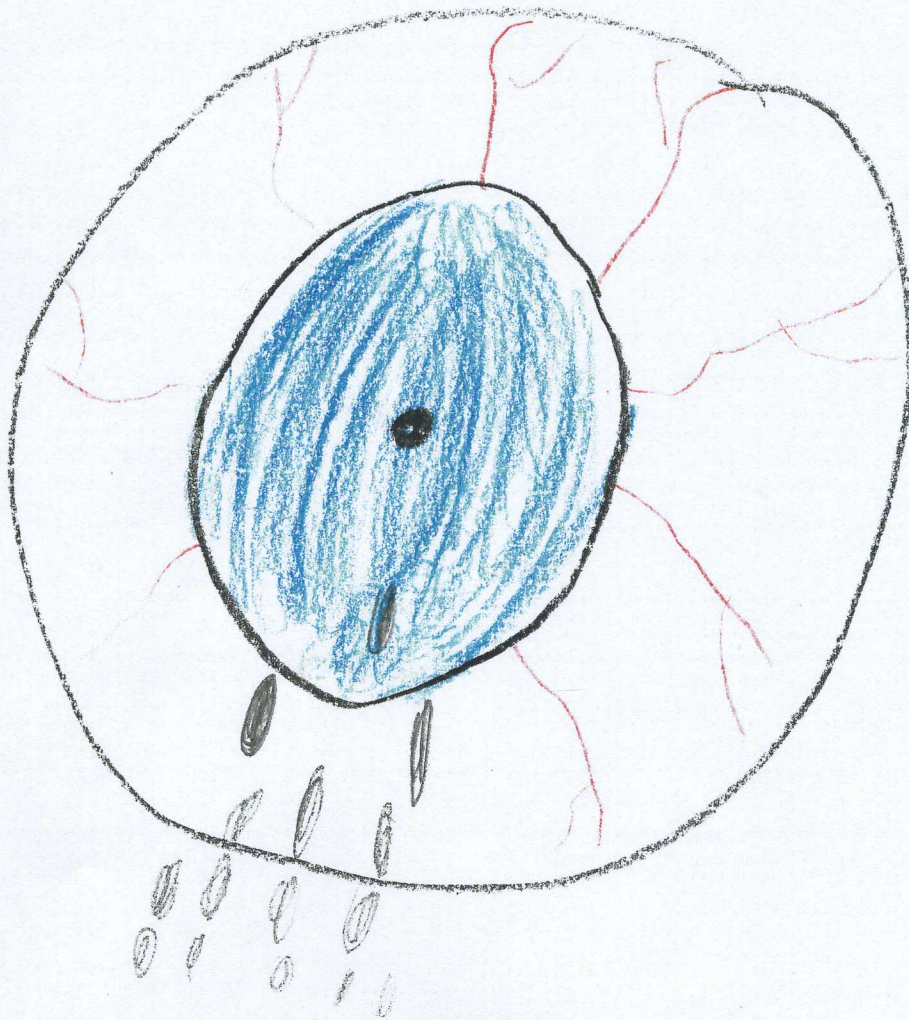

Then, the eyeball saw some caramel and chocolate cookies on the table. The eyeball thought "I wish I could smell those cookies but I am not in my body!"



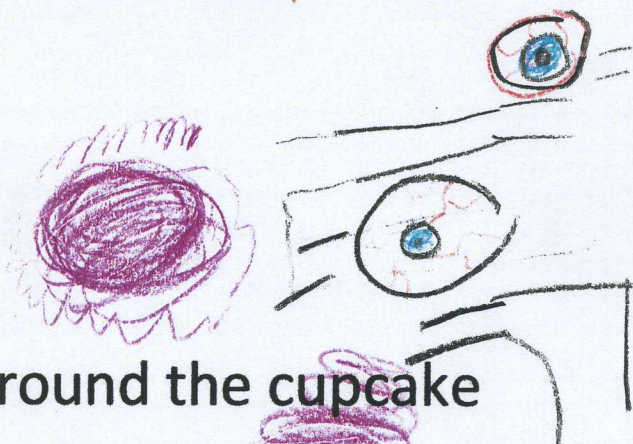
