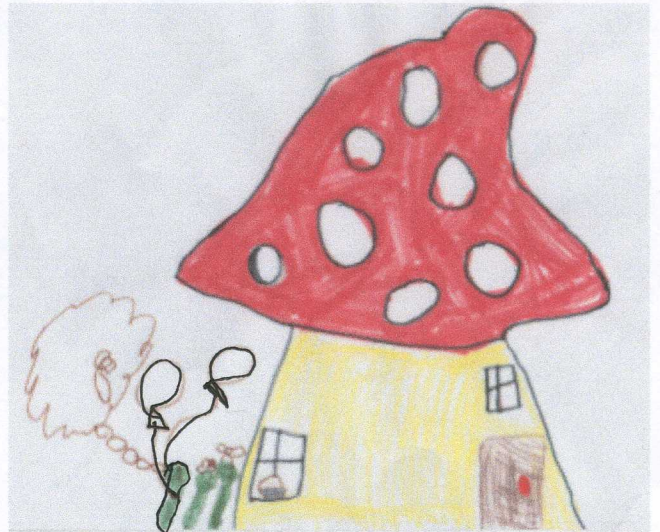


The Wizard and the Three Snakes
